



Thunderbird Overnight Campers Only: Arrival & Departure Travel

BUS TRAVEL (skip if not applicable)

Taking the 'Atlanta Bus' after camp has become a beloved tradition for many campers over the years! It gives campers the opportunity to enjoy those few hours of post-camp travel along with fellow campers and staff, making the transition home a little extra special.

Bus transportation is enjoyed both by Atlanta area families and those for whom Atlanta is closer to home than camp.

This service is offered only on closing days corresponding with our Signature (2-week) Sessions.

The fee for bus transportation is \$225.

If you indicate that your camper will travel via bus and you have not yet paid the applicable fees, we will automatically charge your card on file.

For:

BUS DEPARTURE DETAILS

We arrange for a chartered bus, professionally driven and supervised by camp staff, to transport our campers at the end of their session. This service is offered only on closing days corresponding with our Signature (2-week) Sessions.

Campers (along with their belongings) will leave Camp Thunderbird around 7:30am on their session's closing day and arrive in Atlanta for parent pick-up at about 12:00pm (noon).

*Please Note - though rare, bus transportation to Atlanta may be adjusted to a 'mini-bus' or cancelled in the event of low registration. In that event, we will communicate early and fees will be appropriately refunded.

AIRPLANE TRAVEL (skip if not applicable)

We are happy to provide transportation between camp and Charlotte Douglas International Airport (CLT) in Charlotte, NC.

The fee for one-way transportation (arrival OR departure) is \$80.

The fee for transportation for arrival AND departure is \$150.

If you indicate that your camper will be traveling by airplane and you have not yet paid the applicable fees, we will automatically charge your card on file.

AIRPLANE ARRIVAL INSTRUCTIONS

1. Your camper's flight must be scheduled to arrive between 12:00pm (noon) and 7:00pm on opening day of their session. Any arrivals outside of that timeframe must be approved before purchase and will be subject to an additional fee.
2. You must pay an Unaccompanied Minor Fee with your chosen airline at time of ticket purchase. Each airline has its own unaccompanied minor policy and it is the family's responsibility to confirm with the airline. Please include 'YMCA Camp Thunderbird Staff Member' on the Unaccompanied Minor Form so that your camper can be released to us upon their arrival.
3. We require that campers arriving by flight have their belongings shipped to camp at least one week prior to their session start. Items should NOT arrive as checked luggage with their flight. The family is responsible for shipping fees.

AIRPLANE DEPARTURE INSTRUCTIONS

1. Your camper's flight must be scheduled to depart between 10:00am and 12:00pm (noon) on closing day of their session. Any departures outside of that timeframe must be approved before purchase and will be subject to an additional fee.
2. You must pay an Unaccompanied Minor Fee with your chosen airline at time of ticket purchase. Each airline has its own unaccompanied minor policy and it is the family's responsibility to confirm with the airline. Your camper will not be able to board their flight without the fee being paid in advance. Additionally, if your camper will be traveling with a carry-on bag, please ensure any required fees are paid in advance.
3. We require that campers departing by flight have their belongings shipped home. The family is responsible for shipping fees. Please email a prepaid shipping label for the carrier of your choice to campthunderbird@ymcacharlotte.org. Please include your camper's full name and date of birth and list 'Shipping Label: {Camper's Full Name}' in the subject line.
